Installation

Install the Acoustic Back Can

Mount the [SPKA-BC-IC6/IC8](#) acoustic back can onto a Reference or Ultimate speaker.

1. Install the Reference or Ultimate speaker as per the corresponding Quickstart Guide (refer to document ID [8968](#), [8970](#), or [9036](#)).
2. Connect the wire leads inside the acoustic back can to the inputs on the speaker.

NOTE: Make sure that the back can is secured properly over the speaker – the screw holes of the acoustic back can should sit evenly on the corresponding surface of the speaker housing without any gaps and without having to apply force.

3. Place the back can on the top of the speaker.
4. Insert the six supplied screws into the holes of the back can.
5. Tighten the screws until the back can is secure. Do not overtighten.
6. Connect the speaker wire from the amplifier to the terminals on the outside of the back can.

NOTE: Make sure that the positive cable is attached to the red connection, and the negative cable is attached to the black connection.
