




MENU SELECTION SCREEN

When user taps menu up arrow in the toolbar, menu selection screen is recalled. Based on configured system the list of available options for user to navigate to will be shown.

User dismisses the menu by pressing "back" arrow which will effectively navigate user back to previous screen.

Recalling info screen




INFO SCREEN

Tapping "i" button will bring up "Info" screen which contains some relevant room meta data such as: friendly room name, phone extention, Skype room extension, IP address, and "Next meeting" info if room calendar is configured.

INFO SCREEN DETAILED


Long hold on "i" button (20 s) will bring up detailed "Info" screen which contains system relevant information.

HOME SCREEN USECASES

Home Screen - In The Meeting

Home screen shows current scheduling state of the conference room.





IN THE MEETING SCREEN

When the calendar for the room indicates that the room is currently booked, the user will see a red time counter showing how long until the end of the meeting.


The meeting subject is shown right below "meeting" label. If the meeting title is long and does not fit, text will **auto scroll**. User also has an option to "**touch scroll**" on this element.

Start/end times and organizer info is string together and shown below the meeting title.

If the meeting has join meeting functionality "Join" button will be shown to the user.

JOIN MEETING SCREEN


Join meeting screen will show all relevant (available) information about meeting in

progress and "Join Meeting" button.
When "join Meeting" is pressed, the user will navigate to the appropriate "in a call" conferencing page and the dialing string will be sent to the conferencing device to dial the call.

Home Screen - Room Available

When room is available there are 2 distinct use-cases identified by system:

1 Room Available Till Next Meeting



AVAILABLE TILL NEXT MEETING SCREEN


When the calendar for the room indicates that the room is currently available, the user will see a green time indicator, and the screen will show how long until the next meeting of the day begins.

The user will be able to book the room by pressing the reserve button.

When room is available there are 2 distinct use-cases identified by system:






AVAILABLE FOR THE REST OF THE DAY

When the calendar for the room indicates that the there's no more meetings for the rest of the day, the UI will display this screen.

The user will be able to book the room by pressing the reserve button.

NEW MEETING SCREEN

By default meeting start & meeting end time will be populated till next 30 minutes meeting length. The user will be able to reserve the room for up to three lengths:


- 1. Until the next half hour (i.e. 13 minutes if the time is 2:17)*
- 2. Until the next half hour plus 30 minutes (i.e. 43 minutes if the time is 2:17) *
- 3. Until the next half hour plus 60 minutes (i.e. 73 minutes if the time is 2:17) *

Crestron's "Spinner List" will be used for meeting length selection.

PRESENTING - SINGLE DISPLAY


PRESENT SELECTION SCREEN

The "Present" screen is where the user will be able to route content to the main display in the room.

Once in Present Mode, presentation options are available to be selected. This screen is shown for systems that have one display.




CONNECT TO HDMI PROMPT

When user selects HDMI presentation type but has not connected his device to HDMI cable provided, UI will display "connect to HDMI" screen.




Present AirMedia/Wireless Flow










This is sample control page for "Dvr" source










AUDIO CALL DIALER







"In a Audio Call" page will be displayed if a call has been established.


User can "End" current call, or if needed can bring a simple keypad for dial tone functionality.


SKYPE CALL FIND CONTACT SCREEN

This is the first screen user will see when selecting Skype call option from call selection screen. Using built in keyboard user will be able to perform directory look up or manually dial SIP URI.

After user starts typing the name, system will start "querying" results and provide best matches in scrollable list below the text field. List item will show the users' Skype status', name, title, and call icon. Tapping the contact list item will perform a quick dial to add contact to active call.


SKYPE CALL DIALER






"In a Skype Call" page will be displayed if a call has been established.








AirBoard Shortcut















Recalling present selections screen




MULTI DISPLAY PAGE VIEW

Each display is distinctively shown on a panel with visible display labels. Content sources are grouped in the vertical list view and mirrored on each display. Each source button will have a red/green icon on the right side to indicate if a video signal is present. Each display is configured as an independent rout.

Multi Display — Present User Content Using Hdmi



Multi Display — Present Connected Device Flow




DISPLAY "IN PRESENTATION"
