To install the face plate in existing TSW-760 or TSS-7 installations:

1. Pull the TSW-760 or TSS-7 carefully out its mounting bracket and disconnect all cables from the rear of the touch screen.

NOTE: If the touch screen is secured to the mounting bracket with a security bracket, refer to the removal procedure described in the <u>TSW-560/TSW-760/TSW-1060 Quick Start (Doc. 7926)</u> or the <u>TSS-7/TSS-10 Quick Start (Doc. 8326)</u>.


- 2. Remove the TSW-760/1060 mounting bracket from the electrical box or mounting cutout.
- 3. Attach the face plate to the TSW-770/1070 mounting bracket and electrical box or mounting cutout with the appropriate screws. The mounting bracket and screws are included with the TSW-770 or TSS-770 touch screen.
 - For U.S.-style installations, use the four 6-32 x 3/4 in. screws.
 - For European-style installations, use the four M3 x 16 mm screws.
 - For U.K.-style installations, use the two M3 x 25 mm screws.



Face Plate for TSW-770 Series


